ASSIGNMENT #2 - Reflections on MODULE 1

"Indigenous Philosophy of Turtle Island: What Is It?"

Readings: The written assignment is based on the readings in Module 1 of the course, except that instead of the reading 1.3 on Aztec Philosophy, I am substituting the paper "Indian time: time, seasonality, and culture in Traditional Ecological Knowledge of Climate Change". You will find it on the course website. I think it enriches readings 1.1 and 1.2 and, based on class discussion, would be of more interest to the class.

Written Assignment:

A. Based on the readings and class meetings we have had so far this term, identify a theme or themes you encountered. (1/2 to 1 page, double spaced)
